Dr. Kirstiaan Nevin is an Assistant Professor at Georgetown University School of Medicine and a member of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Medstar Georgetown University Hospital. She is also a member of the Fisher Center for Hereditary Cancer and Clinical Genomic Research at Georgetown. She is responsible for direct patient care, departmental functional and academic responsibilities and the education and training of medical students and resident physicians. Dr. Nevin is board-certified with the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology and is an active member of the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology and the Society for Academic Specialists in General Obstetrics and Gynecology.
