This is Jenn



She is a physician who lives and/or works in the DC area

She wants to be as involved as possible in MSDC

Active member

- Can serve on Board and committees
- Votes in committees and for Board members
- Gets up to two wellness visits covered
- Receives Society emails and news
- Invited to events and webinars

This is Jill



She is a physician who lives or works in the DC area

She wants to be "in the know", but doesn't care about MSDC governance

Associate member

- Can sit in on Board and committee meetings but not vote
- Receives Society emails and news
- Invited to events and webinars but may pay more than Active members



These are Fellows or Residents in DC area programs

They can be Active members (like Jenn) at a special reduced rate.

This is Jones



He can can only be an Associate member, like Jill.

He is a student at a DC area medical school

This is Taylor



They have been in practice for many years and are ready to (mostly) retire

They want to stay engaged with MSDC, so they remain an Active member (but at a lower rate than Jenn).

When they are ready to fully retire and just read eNews, they can become a Life member (no dues).

This is Tanya This is Gloria



She is a nurse



She is neither a physician or allied health person
